WHEREAS, Forsyth County owns a Curtis snow plow and Curtis salt spreader, which are in need of repair and are no longer useful to the County due to their age and condition and should be declared surplus to the County's needs; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. 160A-280 allows counties to donate to another governmental unit any personal property that the Board of County Commissioners deems to be surplus, obsolete, or unused; and

WHEREAS, County staff recommends that the Curtis snow plow and Curtis salt spreader be declared surplus and be donated to the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education, a school administrative unit which is a governmental unit as defined by N.C.G.S. 160A-274(a), to assist with snow removal during inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, the said personal property would be donated on the conditions that the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education agrees that the equipment would be used or disposed of and the proceeds thereof used solely to support the needs of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools System and further agrees to waive all rights to make any claims against the County relating to any failure of performance of the said equipment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.C.G.S. 160A-280, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has caused a public notice of this proposed Resolution to be posted at least five days prior to the adoption of this Resolution approving the donation.
