

FTCC Projects from the 2006 & 2008 Bond Referendum

2006 Bond Referendum

\$25,000,000

Expansion of Woodruff/Swisher Centers

11,000 sq. ft. expansion of each center located in Kernersville and Carver School Road, Winston Salem. Classroom/lab expansions. Cost is \$4,600,000 – Project will be complete for classes in FY 2010-11.

Fire Training Center

22,759 sq. ft. that includes burn building, classroom building, tactical building, burn pits and training tower. Located at the Northwest Forsyth Campus. Cost is \$5,000,000 - Project will be complete for classes in FY 2010-11.

Transportation Technology Center

Renovation of 115,000 sq. ft. of the Pinebrook Shopping Center located at Highway 8 and Patterson Avenue in Winston Salem. This will house auto body, auto mechanics, race car technology, RV maintenance, motorcycle repair and all other transportation programs. Budgeted amount is \$15,400,000. Expected completion is January, 2012.

2008 Bond Referendum

\$23,500,000

304,000 sq. ft renovation of the Career Center that is adjacent to the Main Campus located on Miller Street in Winston Salem.

First Phase: 90,000 sq. ft. that presently houses the Administrative area of the school system. Will renovate for classrooms and labs. Expected completion is summer of 2011. Budget is \$8,000,000.

Second Phase: 214,000 sq. ft. that presently houses the Career Center of the school system. Will renovate for classrooms and labs. Expected completion is summer of 2012. Budget is \$12,500,000.

Third Phase: Main Campus renovations that will relocate the electrical pad and the power plant for main campus and renovate parts of several buildings. Expected completion date is January, 2014. Budget is \$3,000,000.
