This is a re-opening of the FY23 Behavioral Health Funding Request for Proposals ("RFP") to qualified applicants to provide mental Health, substance use, and developmental disabilities services in Forsyth County. The RFP was originally posted on February 1, 2022. Forsyth County will consider all proposals received in response to the initial February FY23 Behavioral Health Funding RFP, in addition to any new responses received after this reopening. **IF YOU RESPONDED TO THE ORIGINAL RFP BY THE DUE DATE AND TIME, YOU DO NOT NEED TO RESUBMIT YOUR PROPOSAL.** However, respondents to the February RFP are free to change or supplement their previous response or to provide a new response. Please indicate on the cover of your proposal if you are submitting a supplement, change or replacement application. Application changes are optional for those who responded by the due date and time to the initial February RFP, and no negative inference will be made with regard to any respondent that chooses not to change, update or supplement a previous application.

Forsyth County anticipates an allocation of behavioral health funds in the amount stated above to fund the priorities specified below. Such programs will serve the behavioral health needs of children and adults for the fiscal year 2022-2023 beginning July 1, 2022. The use of these funds requires an agency match in the amount specified above. The match may be in-kind or cash or both.

Behavioral Health includes: Mental Health, Substance Use, and Developmental Disabilities.

The County will consider proposals for programs related to the following:

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| 1. Jail and/or Emergency Department Diversion | 6. Transitional Housing |
| 2. Peer Support Services | 7. Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy or Trauma Informed Counseling |
| 3. Psychological, Substance abuse treatment, evaluations & assessments | 8. Transportation to treatment/appointments |
| 4. Education, outreach, and/or training efforts | 9. Developmental Disabilities Support Services |
| 5. Harm reduction services | 10. Respite services |

Applicants are being sought that are able to address the following:

1. Program services are outcome based and measurable.
2. The program has an evaluation component.
3. Program services reflect innovation, if applicable.
4. Program services reflect collaboration and identify partners addressing the needs of the consumer.

Local public agencies and 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the priorities above. Private non-profits are also required to submit proof of 501(c)(3) status.
